

Job Title: Maintenance Development Lead Organization: Lake Geneva Foundation (LGF)

Reports to: Operations Director

Position Summary:

This is a multi-faceted role to directly assist with property maintenance involving; 1) hands on orchestration of daily facility maintenance, 2) developing a Trades-skilled training program for young adults, and 3) coordination of volunteer efforts to perform regular maintenance assistance.

Position Responsibilities:

- Under the direction of the two property managers, perform hands-on facilities maintenance individually and as leader of a team. Facility maintenance responsibilities will be:
 - Oversee all necessary maintenance and repairs of the grounds and buildings under the LGF umbrella
 - Assist with maintenance of grounds and landscaping that affect guest experience
 - Assist with piers; care and maintenance
 - Open and close seasonal buildings
 - o Power-wash and paint building exteriors, decks and walkways
 - o Provide project support
 - Assist with snow removal
- Develop a skilled training program for young adults (mission supported students):
 - o Develop a two year certification program to train students in skilled labor development
 - o Recruit young college age+ men (initially) for a two year commitment to the program
 - Develop the training curriculum and schedule training times, coordinating with necessary maintenance needs and projects
 - Disciple each student in spiritual disciplines and hold weekly 1:1 coaching sessions with each
 - Establish benchmarks and course completion competencies
 - Work side-by-side with students in hands on maintenance efforts weekly
 - Target outcomes: a strong Christian faith, a developed sense of self-worth,100% marketable skill and placement
- Organize volunteer efforts towards property maintenance:
 - Recruit partner churches and others for camp workdays
 - o Recruit organizations with the ministry's target demographic of young college age+ men who desire skills
 - o Plan and execute volunteer events, with schedule coordination with the property managers

Essential skills and additional requirements:

- Faith Passionate about the gospel message and the camping ministry
- Strong communication skills Efficiently and effectively communicate, especially with your Maintenance peers
- Leadership Proven ability to lead young men in their Christian faith, practical living and labor skill development
- Technical Expertise Experience in a specific trade and strong working knowledge of construction
- Operational excellence Exhibit an expectation of excellence and an ability to problem solve and work alongside others
